Measuring College and Career Readiness

NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

- In 2015, New Jersey adopted the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) to replace HSPA NJASK tests in language arts and mathematics.
- Students now take English Language Arts and Math PARCC tests digitally in grades 3 – 11.
- PARCC tests were administered for the 4th consecutive year in the Spring of 2018.
- PARCC tests will be modified and renamed for Spring 2019 administration (NJSLA-ELA / NJSLA-M)

PARCC PERFORMANCE LEVELS

- Level 1: Not yet meeting grade-level expectations
- Level 2: Partially meeting grade-level expectations
- Level 3: Approaching grade-level expectations
- Level 4: Meeting grade-level expectations
- Level 5: Exceeding grade-level expectations







PARENT GUIDE TO THE SCORE REPORTS



Key Information Provided in the Score Report

Overall Student Performance – This section of the report shows your student's overall numerical score and the performance level achieved based on that score. Level 1 indicates a student is not yet meeting grade level expectations and Level 5 indicates the student has a strong understanding of grade level material.

Page two of the score report provides additional information about your child's score and level of performance. Level 4 and above indicates that a student meets or exceeds grade level expectations and is well prepared for the next grade level.

Score Graph - The colored graph shows the score ranges for each performance level and where your child's score falls within that range. This gives you an indication of how close your child is to achieving the next level.
